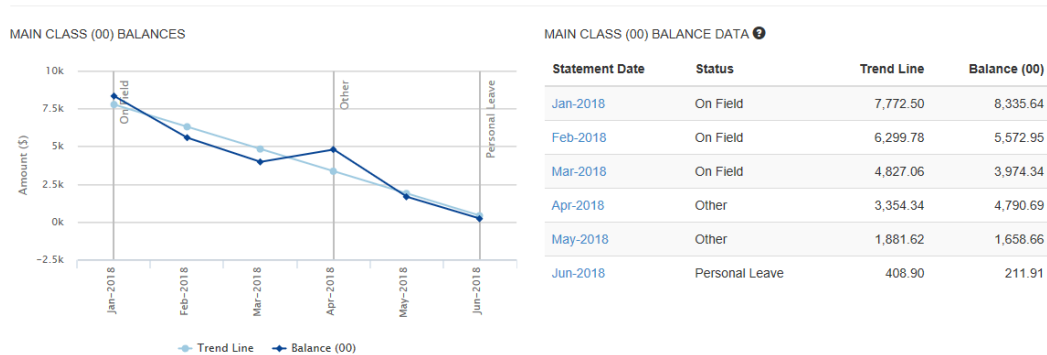

Dear friends and supporters,

Our family is scheduled to leave for Abidjan in 7 days. **We are in a great need of work funds and this is an URGENT APPEAL.** For the first time in 13 years as missionaries, we no longer have the funds to do the work that we have been sent to do. We want to thank all of you for the monthly support we have received – we have consistently received 70-80% of our pledges. However, our transition to Abidjan, Ivory Coast, a full year of ministry, and recent medical and travel expenses have left our cash funds depleted.

In October, we will be hosting a building/evangelism team from Shreveport, Louisiana.

Please pray that the Holy Spirit will guide us to the lost and that we will see many more people find a new life in Christ.
