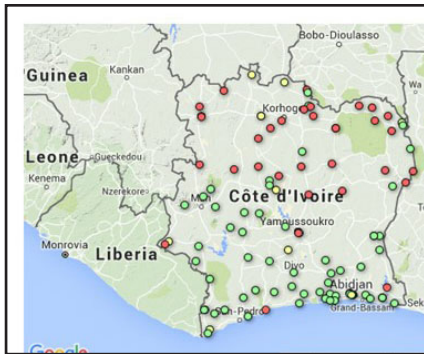

Ivory Coast Stats

- Country population: 25 million
- Capital city (Abidjan) is a port city
- 3rd largest French-speaking city in the world
- 66 different languages
- 45% Muslim
- 10% Evangelical Christian
- 95% practice worship of ancestral spirits
- It is estimated that 1/3 of the country is unreached with the gospel
- The small communities of believers in the north are often persecuted and considered 0% Christian.



Red dots represent people groups who are considered unreached with gospel.

- The 3 Bible institutes in the interior need more resources and instructors, and there is a need for a new university center to be developed in Abidjan. Last year more than 2,000 lay ministers applied for training and only 100 could be accepted due to lack of resources and faculty.



When We Get There

We will partner with the Ivorian church in **evangelism, education, church planting and compassion ministries**. Kristy, Luke and Lillian will study French as our family adjusts to living in Abidjan. We will assist local churches, travel to support and work with new church plants, and use our background in education to teach students and help equip institutes and libraries.

Goals and Ongoing Projects

- The national church has a goal of 5,000 new church plants in the next 10 years and to build 200 new church structures.



- Continued ministry at the Women's Integration Center that houses and helps persecuted women and their children.
- The national church has a goal to build 10 more of these integration centers throughout the country.
