Church-planting and Training. Hundreds of local church leaders have been trained in Cote D'Ivoire through 6 centers established across Cote d'Ivoire. Tim has also been training students at the undergraduate level online in Africa, Europe, and North America. The crisis worldwide has resulted in a much greater number of people seeking training. Since April, Tim has taught 8 courses online to over 300 French-speaking church planters and pastors in Ivory Coast, France, Italy, Belgium, England, and Canada through Global University and the West Africa Advanced School of Theology. Tim is currently building an online school that will allow for research and training for French-speaking church leaders worldwide. These are exciting days!
