All of us have been practicing French. We travel north next week to Daloa where Tim will be teaching Missions at one of the Bible institutes.

Unreached People Groups

Our primary purpose as missionaries is to reach the "unreached." Since 2013, we have been helping to plant and build churches in the north where many areas are 0% reached with the gospel.

One of the first families to welcome us to the Ivory Coast is from this region. The couple serve in a local church and are helping our mission build tabernacles in the north.

What a blessing to hear their testimony! Both were raised in strict Islamic homes, but through the power of the Holy Spirit and Christian witnesses, they now serve the Risen Lord - Jesus Christ!

Twice a year they take a month to worship in their home and provide an Agape feast every night. Tim was asked to speak to the group on the topic of Thanksgiving.

What a confirmation that we are exactly where God wants us to be. Not only are we celebrating "Thanksgiving" early, but we are privileged to do so with members of one of the people groups we are reaching out to in the north.
